Prof. Minxhozi has been a lecturer for the subjects "Political Economy", "Capitalism", "History of Economic Doctrines" for 11 years at the Faculty of Economics at the University of Tirana.

From 1996 to 2002 while at the University of Tirana, Faculty of Economics she also lectured the subjects "Introduction to Microeconomics and Macroeconomics" and "Development Economics". During this period Prof. Minxhozi has taught in other academic institutions inside the country and abroad, such as the

Institute for Central-Eastern Europe and the Balkans based in Bologna, Italy and the New York University in Tirana. From 2008 to 2018 Prof. Minxhozi served as a full-time professor at the European University of Tirana covering the position of Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Information Technology.

Currently, Prof. Minxhozi serves as the First Deputy Governor of the Bank of Albania.
